



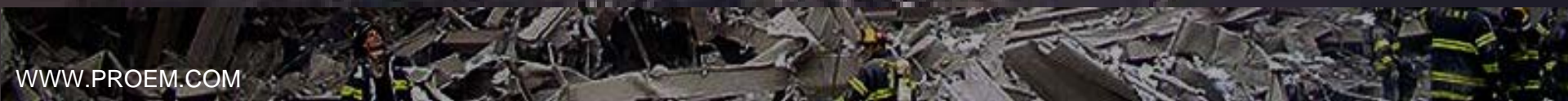

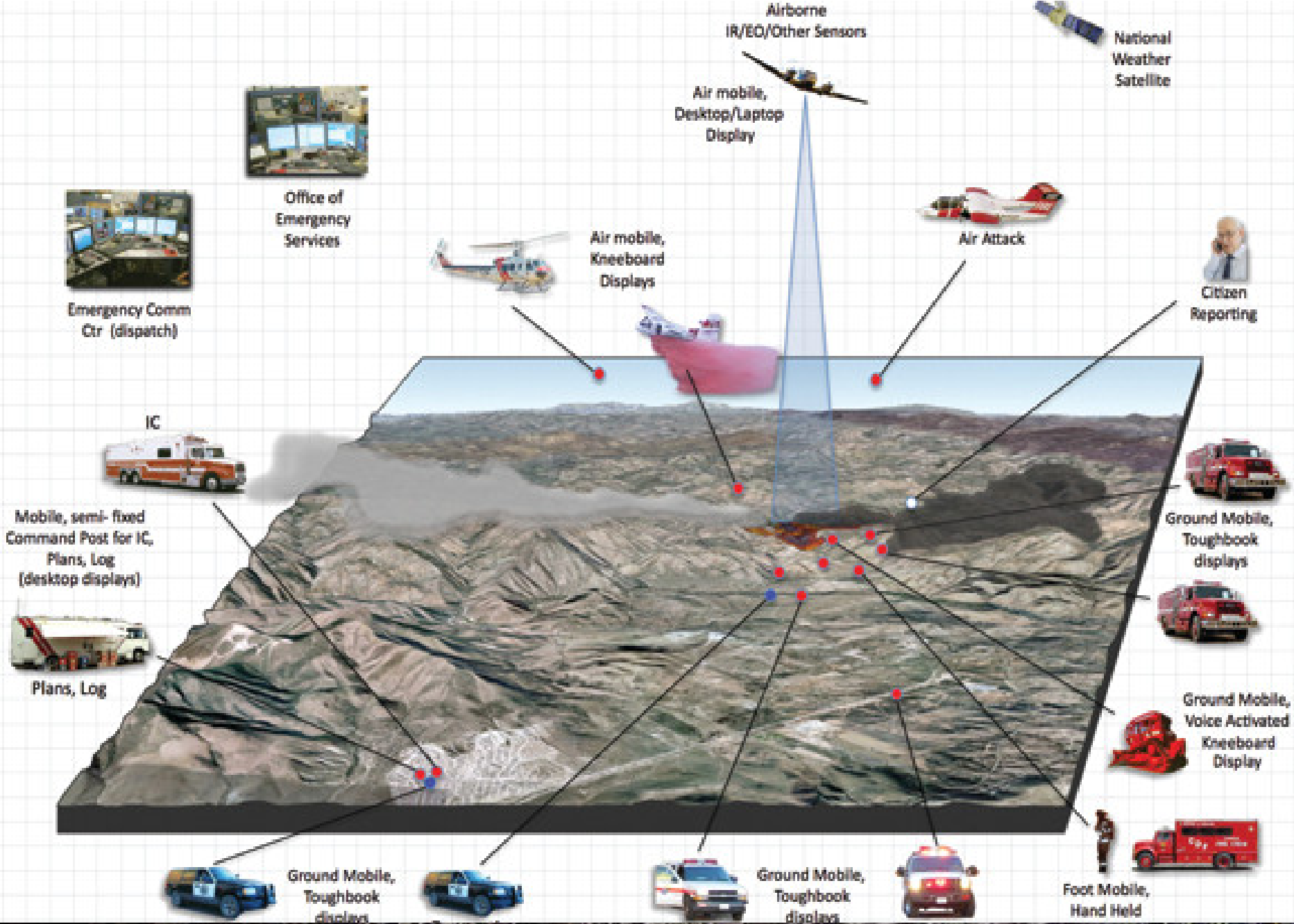

Scaleable for all Incidents

- Fires, hazardous materials, multi-casualty incidents
- Single and multi-agency law enforcement incidents
- Multi jurisdictional and multi agency disaster response
- Search and rescue missions
- Oil spill response and recovery incidents
- Air, rail, water, or ground transportation
- Planned events such as parades, celebrations, concerts

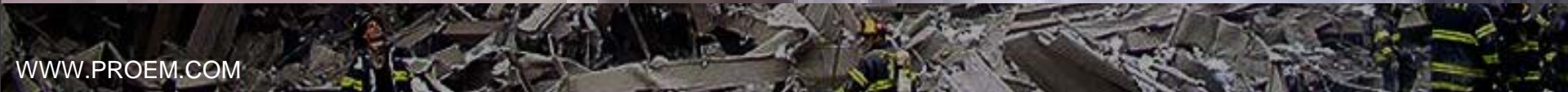

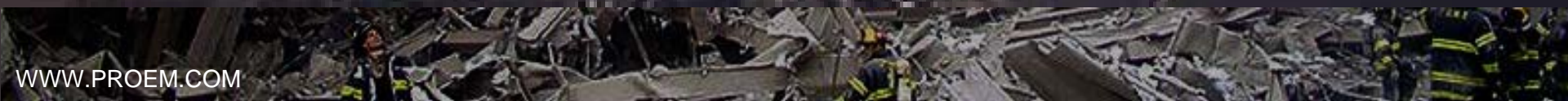

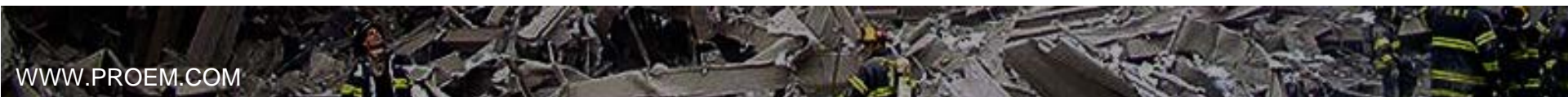
